These are example cheers for spirit, offense, defense, and free throws\rebounding. If you see an "X" it represents a clap in the cheer. Of course, you will have to fill in things like your players' names, your mascot, and the opposing team's mascot.

Spirit Cheers

- Maroon, Maroon and White, Maroon and Whites let's fight [change to your colors]
- W-I-N, fight to win
- F-I, XX, G-H-T, XX fight, for, a victory
- We are Maroon and White [change to your colors], [Your Mascot], yeah that's right
- Come on [Your Mascot] lets go, G-O, G-O
- B-E-A-T, beat the [Opposing Mascot]
- Hey, Hey, Here we go, [Your Mascot] here we go
- We're here, XX, to beat the [Opposing Mascot]
- Shout it out let's hear it, [Player's Name] have spirit

Offense Cheers

- Two more, two more, XX, Come on [Your Mascot] let's up that score
- O-F-F-E-N-S-E, offense XX offense
- Shoot two XX, shoot two XXX put it in the hoop for two
- [Your Mascot] score XX two points more
- S-C-O-R-E, score [Your Mascot] score

Defense Cheer

- D-E-F-E-N-S-E, defense XX defense
- T-A-K-E, take that ball away
- A-T-T-A-C-K, attack XX attack

Free Throw Cheers

Offensive Free Throws

- S-I-N-K, sink it [Player's Name] sink it hey
- Make that shot, [Player's Name], make that shot

Defensive Free Throws

- R-E-B-O-U-N-D, rebound that basketball
- Rebound XX rebound XX come on [Player's Name] pull it down
